**Dr. Cummins** is a professor at the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education where he works on language development and literacy development of ELLs as an additional language. Cummins coined the acronyms BICS and CALP, processes to help a teacher qualify a student's language ability. His research has focused on the nature of language proficiency and second language acquisition with emphasis on the social and educational barriers that limit academic success for culturally diverse students.

**Dr. Escamilla** is a professor of Education at the University of Colorado at Boulder. Her work centers on educational issues related to Spanish-speaking language minority students in U.S. schools. She is specifically interested in issues related to the development of bilingualism and bi-literacy in early elementary grades for this population. Her recent research has also examined assessment practices and the impact of high stakes testing.
